

COGHLAN STILL AT THE RACES

Last Post takes off its proverbial hat to former 1,500 metre legend Eamonn Coghlan, who is never found wanting in the energy stakes. Coghlan is to be race director of the four-mile race being run in the Phoenix Park on St Patrick's Day.

Eamonn follows in his father's footsteps, as Bill Coghlan was race director of the first ever St Patrick's day road race in 1983, which Eamonn won.
